

# Halloween 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Party Plan



*Note: Only supplies can be sent to school for parties. Please do not have parents send money to school.*

## Games:

1. **Limbo** – have two adults hold a strip of crepe paper streamer, ribbon or a broom handle as the children limbo underneath. Play Halloween music in the background.
2. **Halloween Word Scramble** – Divide class into five teams. Each team is given a Ziploc bag labeled that contains letters that spell a Halloween word. It is a race to see which team can unscramble the word first. Have several words ready for unscrambling.

**Word Bank:** trick, treat, bones, ghost, witch, candy, broom, bats, spider, scare

3. **Pumpkin Hunt** –select a student to hide a small pumpkin somewhere in the classroom while the other students hide their eyes. The students all search for the pumpkin. The child who finds the pumpkin gets a turn hiding it, etc.

## Craft:

**Bat Flyer** – See directions on page 2. I recommend using cardstock for the bats. Kids can color the bats before cutting out. <https://www.education.com/download/worksheet/63965/bat-flyers.pdf>

## Snack:

1. Have children spread orange frosting on top of a graham cracker with Popsicle sticks. Kids can decorate their square with gummy worms and other Halloween candies.
2. Water bottles (small size)

**More bats** on the second page!



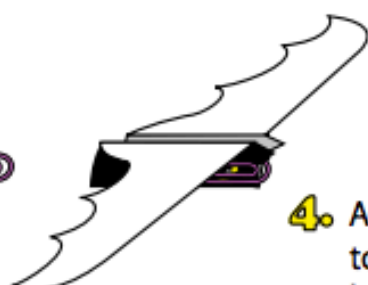
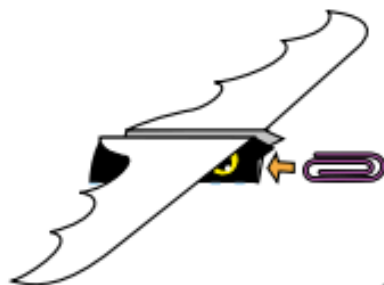
**1.** Fold the bat in half, printed side out.
