



Kindergarten Halloween Party Plans



Note: *Only supplies can be sent to school for parties. Please do not have parents send money to school.*

GAMES:

- 1. Candy Corn Relay Race** – divide class into two groups. Give each group a two bowls; one should be full of candy corn. Kids race to take scoops of candy corn using a spoon from one bowl to another. The first team who empties their bowl wins! [Play again with boys vs. girls or adults vs. kids.]
- 2. Pass the Pumpkin Game** - This Halloween party game for kids is similar to the old Hot Potato game. Kids pass around mini pumpkins while sitting in a circle and if they're caught holding the pumpkin when the music stops then they're out.
- 3. BINGO** – Play Halloween Bingo. Use candy corn or Smarties for the markers. Find a set to print here: <https://fun-squared.com/halloween-bingo/>

CRAFT:

Create a Door Hanger– Cut 8 x11 cardstock in half lengthwise. Cut a circle out of the middle at the top end and a little slit from the circle to the edge of the paper. Have the students write their name (ex. "Sally's Room") with crayon or sticker letters on one side and "Do Not Disturb" on the other. Decorate the door hanger with stickers, and crayons.

STORY & SNACK: Have an adult read a Halloween book or two aloud while the students enjoy their snack.
